Pinky worked in various front office capacities with the Sisters School District from 1988 until her retirement in 2014. She was a necessary conduit between parents and school administrators and teachers when most needed. She was instrumental in the re-opening of Sisters High School in 1992, and the smooth transition to the new high school in 2003.
