Audrey also received numerous academic excellence awards and was an enthusiastic I.E.E. Intern. These programs guided her to volunteer in Nepal with the local nonprofit, Ten Friends, as well as returning to volunteer with I.E.E. any chance she could. Audrey first attended Whitman College (starting on the soccer team) and graduated from Southern Oregon University (Environmental Studies degree with focus areas of Politics and Conservation Biology).
